## 3-POINTS SHOOTOUT CONTEST - ALL STAR GAME

The LNB set up the present official rules regarding the organization of the 3 point shootout.

An official supervisor of the All Star Game, picked by LNB, will be there to make sure that this present rules are respected. The official supervisor can be brought to make any decision of refereeing for any possible complaint.

## 1. Running of the contest

4 players participate in this contest.
The contest takes place in $\mathbf{2}$ rounds:

- before the All Star Game : Qualifying round
- between the $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ quarter of the All Star Game : Final round (opposing the best 2 players of the qualifying round).

For each round, each participant has 1 attempt at the shootout. The starting order is determined by a draw.

## 2. Attempts

Each participant has to go through $\mathbf{5}$ shooting positions behind the three-point arc, in a maximum time of one minute
Each shooting position has 5 balls: four normal balls worth one point each and a coloured ball worth $\mathbf{2}$ points

Each participant can try a mid-court shot, worth three points, if and only if he has taken the 25 shots in one minute or less. There's no time limit for this half court shot

## 3. Ranking

## The ranking is made by adding the number of points for each shot made (with a maximum of thirty-three points)

If players score the same total, they shoot the 5 balls of the middle shooting position. Participant has 12 seconds to realize the 5 shoots, normal balls worth one point each and coloured ball worth 2 points.

If players still score the same total, they shoot 1 ball each of the middle shooting position until one miss and the other score.

The Final will oppose the two players who have achieved the best scores and it will follow the same principle as the qualifying round

The starting order will be identical to the qualifying round
The winner will be the player who scores the most points in the Final

If players score the same total, they shoot the 5 balls of the middle shooting position. Participant has 12 seconds to realize the 5 shoots, normal balls worth one point each and coloured ball worth 2 points.

If players still score the same total, they shoot 1 ball each of the middle shooting position until one miss and the other score.
