



DUNK CONTEST - ALL STAR GAME

The LNB set up the present official rules regarding the organization of the dunk contest.

An official supervisor of the All Star Game, picked by LNB, will be there to make sure that this present rules are respected. The official supervisor can be brought to make any decision of refereeing for any possible complaint.

1. Running of the contest

There are **4 players** in this contest.

The contest is composed of **2 rounds**:

- Qualifying round
- Final round (between the players who finished at the first and second rank in the qualifying round)

For each round, a player has two attempts, passed alternatively with the other player (starting order decided by a draw).

2. Rounds

Each contestant has **one minute and thirty seconds** to complete a dunk.

The countdown is started by the Speaker.

Only the first dunk completed is evaluated.

A dunk is considered successful when the ball is smashed with force and it goes directly through the rim

A dunk is evaluated by measuring with a decibel meter the noise made by the attending crowd



3. Ranking

The final ranking is established based on the sound evaluation of each dunk

The Final will be played between the contestants who collected the best two aggregated score (starting order identical to the qualifying round)

If the two players have the same aggregated score, they both have to realise a new dunk. The player receiving the best evaluation for this new attempt is the finalist

The winner of the contest is the finalist who achieves the best aggregated score on the two dunks he realised during the final round

If the two players have the same aggregated score, they both have to realise a new dunk. The player receiving the best evaluation for this new attempt is the winner

If they still present the same score after this new attempt, they will be declared co-winners.
